
Provide proof about your pet's good behavior - 2021 Guide

Many landlords and property companies are cautious about letting in pets into their apartment since they have to hear complaints about the noise, trouble, and inconvenience that these pets make. Often bad behaved and spoiled pets create a bad reputation for all of the pet animals, such that the owners don't want to take a risk on having other pet animals in the apartments.



Unless and until your pet is your emotional support animal and you have the appropriate <u>emotional</u> <u>support dog letter</u>, you will need to be scrupulous in your choice of living. You will have the extra responsibility of making sure that you and your pet animal won't face any problems in the future while living in the apartment.

Here we provide you a guide to help you tackle this problem and find the apartment where you can be assured of living with your pet with no landlord or neighbors giving you any trouble.

A good way to ensure that your pet is allowed to live with you in the apartment is to show the owners the proof that your pet is a well-behaved animal (which it must be).

These documents can be:

Providing reference with contact information about the experience of the previous landlord with you and your fellow pet animal as companions.

Offer to pay a pet deposit (refundable) that will assure the owner that the damages will be covered by you if your pet animals destruct anything on the property or damages any possession of the tenants. You can go the extra step and talk to the tenants who might be near the apartment and show them what a good tenant your pet animal can be.

Offer monthly pet fees for the extra cleaning that the cleaning crew or the apartment maintenance has to do directly or indirectly because of your pet animals.

A written and signed document (if you are very confident about your animal's behavior) that the penalties incurred by the landlord will be accepted if the pet is at fault.

Have the permission in writing

Allowing you to have the pet inside the apartment verbally is another thing, and having the permission in writing signed by the landlord is another. Many pet parents take the word of the landlords and start living in the rental unit, only for them to change their <u>ESA Letter</u>. When this happens you have no legal way of stopping them from making you leave the apartment. A situation as such no matter how far down the road, can become a nightmare, and moreover, it can be used to make you evacuate the apartment at their own whim.

This especially occurs when the apartment owners give the verbal affirmation for the tenants to have with them their pets in the apartment, but have them sign a lease paper that clearly says 'no pets allowed in the apartments'. Save yourself the trouble and read the lease carefully, and make a separate agreement for your pet animal signed by the apartment owner.
